VARIOUS PLACES WERE DISCUSSED AS TO WHERE THE POLICE DEPARTMENT COULD GO.

ALDERMAN WILLIAMS MADE THE MOTION AND ALDERMAN BLANKENSHIP SECONDED IT. TOWN OF DECATURVILLE WILL SELL THIS PROPERTY TO THE AMERICAN LEGION FOR \$10,000 AND THE AMERICAN LEGION WILL DO THE DOZER WORK WITH THE INTENT FOR IT TO BENEFIT THE CITY OF DECATURVILLE AND BE USED FOR GOVERNMENTAL PURPOSES INCLUDING EVENTS OPEN TO THE PUBLIC PROVIDING SERVICES TO GENERATE REVENUE AND USED AS A WARMING CENTER IN TIMES OF DISASTER, ALSO THE CITY OF DECATURVILLE TO USE FOR MEETINGS.


